- ✓ All Solid Waste and Recycling containers must be marked with the address of the associated property and the name of the collection contractor (e.g. "300 Bourbon Street, XYZ Collection & Waste").
- ✓ All Solid Waste must be placed in containers with tight fitting lids. Solid waste containers **must not be overfilled** – the lid must be closed and **any excess must be placed in fastened 3.0 mil thick black plastic bags** next to the solid waste containers. Cardboard boxes cannot be used as waste containers. **All unmarked containers will be disposed.**
- ✓ Solid waste containers and bags cannot be placed on curbs or sidewalks at any time.
- ✓ Solid waste containers and bags must be transported to or from the designated staging locations at each corner, by each property's owners or tenants, based on the following schedule:

For Morning Collections

Placement in Corral	Collection Time	Removal Time from Corral
Before 4:00 a.m.	Between 4:00 a.m. – 8:00 a.m.	8:00 a.m.

For Evening Collections

Placement in Corral	Collection Time	Removal Time from Corral
Between 4:00 p.m. and 5:00 p.m.	Between 5:00 p.m. and 7:00 p.m.	7:00 p.m.

We have met with the Solid Waste Contractors and they understand the importance of following the required scheduled. In order to manage the clean-up operation and prevent traffic congestion, property owners must make arrangements to follow the schedule as outlined.
