

TIPS FOR REPORTING STR VIOLATIONS

- Be specific.
- If possible, please provide an address.
- Include any dates or times you are aware of violations taking place.
- Note any pattern to activity that you have been able to observe.
- Describe the nature of the violation in detail.
- If you would like follow-up concerning the resolution of the violation, please provide your name and contact information.
- If you would like to attend any resulting adjudication, please state this in the violation description.

If the property is in the French Quarter and is not disruptive, no additional description is needed.
