

## Sanitation Survey

These services include mechanical street sweeping and flushing, pressure washing of sidewalks and designated areas, public litter can collection, litter removal, and special event clean-up.

The seven-year contract for the current sanitation provider, Empire Services, expires in December 2021. This survey will assist VCPORA to best advocate for their membership for the new City sanitation contract Request For Proposals (RFP) process.

## City Hall Relocation Meeting

Tuesday, May 18

5:45 p.m.

There will be a community meeting next week to discuss the Mayor's proposed relocation of City Hall to the Municipal Auditorium in Armstrong Park. As a reminder, this proposal would require a full renovation of the Municipal Auditorium, which is estimated to cost between \$100 and \$150 million dollars, as well as the construction of a new parking garage within the parking to accommodate the influx of new visitors.

This meeting will be hosted by collaborating organizations including:

- Greater Treme Consortium
- New Orleans Cultural Preservation Committee
- Ole & Nu Style Fellas
- Treme Sidewalk Steppers
- Unity 4NOLA Culture

A public meeting in January presented [details of the plan](#). At that meeting, Tremé and French Quarter neighbors expressed concern over cost, storm water management, congestion, and utility of the proposed use. Despite this, the City of New Orleans has put out a request for qualifications for both the [project management](#) and the [architecture and structural engineering](#) of a Municipal Auditorium renovation. We will provide updates on this project as they develop.




## Blue Bikes to Return in Fall

In case you missed it, the Blue Bikes bike share system is set to return to the City of New Orleans this fall under the management of newly formed non-profit [Blue Krewe](#). They plan to launch the fleet of 500 e-assist bikes by September 1, 2021. VCPORA was able to confirm in a meeting with Blue Krewe representatives last week that the returning fleet will make use of the existing Blue Bike infrastructure, and will require no new stations in the Quarter at the time of launch. 
