Claiborne Avenue Alliance Pop-Up

The Claiborne Avenue Alliance is inviting residents to an urban design pop-up to gather their thoughts, comments or suggestions on a broad vision for the Claiborne Corridor, the Municipal Auditorium, and the City of New Orleans. The pop-up is open now through August 6 at the Craig School Campus of Homer Plessy, [1423 St. Philip St](#), from Monday - Friday 11:00 a.m. - 2:00 p.m. and Saturday from 10:00 a.m. - 2:00 p.m.

At the urban design pop-up, participants will be able to register feedback, which will be incorporated into a 3-D model of the Claiborne Corridor that will be built block by block through a collaboration of the Alliance and Collective Form.
